Olympic Trials Info – 2012 Olympic Trials have been awarded to Omaha, NE for June 25-July 2, 2012 at the Qwest Center. Time standards will not be set until the Fall of 2010 at the earliest. Tentative qualifying period start date will be October 1, 2009. Hotels will not be opened for reservations until mid-2010. USA Swimming will notify teams via email and its website when hotels are available.
